

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH OHIO CAT FOR A MINI HYDRAULIC EXCAVATOR FOR THE STORM WATER DIVISION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase equipment through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price from Ohio Cat, Broadview Heights, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. STS 515-800525 for one mini hydraulic excavator in the amount of \$94,399.58 for the purpose of eliminating the annual cost of renting such equipment; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of a mini hydraulic excavator for the Storm Water Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Ohio Cat, Broadview Heights, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. STS 515-800525 for one mini hydraulic excavator at a total cost not to exceed \$94,399.58, and as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid purchase must be made as soon as possible to secure the specific equipment for the provision of critical public services and to secure the lowest price; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
