**A RESOLUTION THANKING MRS. LAURA CHURCH
FOR HER SERVICE TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY.**

WHEREAS, Mrs. Laura Church was appointed by City Council on September 17, 2008, to serve on the Architectural & Historic Board of Review; she was re-appointed to serve an additional term in 2012; and she was appointed by the Board to perform the following additional duties: Historic District Subcommittee Member from 2009 through the remainder of her tenure; Board Secretary during 2009, 2010, 2011, 2014, and 2015, and Vice Chair during 2012 and 2013; and

WHEREAS, as a self-described “old building enthusiast,” Mrs. Church’s interest in historic structures and the preservation of Hudson’s historic architectural character has been invaluable to the Board; and her personal residence, an historic landmark property, contributed to a deeper understanding of the commitments of stewardship and respectful maintenance of an historic home; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Church has been a reliable, responsive, responsible and contributing member of the Architectural & Historic Board of Review and Historic District Subcommittee; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Church did not seek re-appointment upon completion of her term, which expired on June 20, 2016; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to recognize Mrs. Church for her service on the Architectural & Historic Board of Review and for her willingness to share her time, knowledge, and talents for the good of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that the Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, on behalf of itself and the citizens of Hudson, expresses its thanks and gratitude to Mrs. Laura Church for eight years of service on the Architectural & Historic Board of Review.
