A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE STATE OF OHIO PRESERVATION OFFICE FOR A CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Preservation Office awards Certified Local Government grant funding for the purpose of advancing historic preservation efforts of local governments; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has applied for and could receive Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) in grant funding to cover consultant work required to complete the filing of the Hudson Historic District Extension to include Elm Street and Roslyn Avenue. If the grant is awarded, no local matching funds are required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> Council hereby affirms the City Manager's designee's actions to execute and file an application with the State of Ohio Preservation Office for Certified Local Government Grant funding, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
