

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER’S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE DIVISION OF STATE FIRE MARSHAL FOR A 2019 FIRE DEPARTMENT TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal, provides funding for fire departments and has accepted applications for the 2019 Fire Department Training Reimbursement Grant; and

WHEREAS, this grant could provide up to \$1,800.00 in funding to assist with the cost of training four new volunteers to the level of Volunteer Firefighter; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager’s designee has submitted a grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby affirms the City Manager’s designee’s actions to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
