

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CLAIRHAVEN/COLONY STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PHASE 1 AND PHASE 2, WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, sections of Clairhaven Road and Colony Drive, from Village View Place to Sunset are curbed roadways with little or no storm sewer systems: on Clairhaven Road, there is a storm sewer system and roadway inlets on one side of the road; on Colony Drive, there is no storm sewer system in this area; and

WHEREAS, many of the residential properties downspouts and sump pumps drain into front yards or onto the street, and that during winter months the excess water can cause freezing and ice buildup along the roadways; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the City install a new storm collection system along the easterly sections of Clairhaven Road and Colony Drive from Village View Place to Sunset Drive to mitigate the drainage issues and allow downspout connection for new development in these areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineering Department will design the project in-house and anticipates that the project can be completed by Fall 2023; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project with a 10% contingency is not expected to exceed \$200,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise for a period of at least two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality, requesting the submission of bids for the Clairhaven Road and Colony Drive storm sewer improvement project phase 1 and phase 2 in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid shall not exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00), the Engineer's estimated project cost and amount budgeted for this project.

Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject any and all bids for said contract, if deemed it is necessary to do so.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
