## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO BID AND AWARD FOR THE MARKETING SERVICES OF VELOCITY BROADBAND.

WHEREAS, the City Staff seeks to bid and secure a one-year marketing services contract with a firm that is best fit to continue the current design, development, and distribution of the marketing campaigns for Velocity Broadband; and

WHEREAS, these marketing efforts will keep future customers and new property owners aware of the available Velocity Broadband services along with new features and products to existing customers who might choose to take additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, Ohio, as follows:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the marketing services of Velocity Broadband.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City in an amount to be appropriated by Council, up to the amount of Eighteen Thousand Dollars.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract or contracts if deemed necessary to do so.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
