

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE OF A GRANT TO PROVIDE BODY ARMOR THROUGH THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR OHIO LAW ENFORCEMENT BODY ARMOR PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 18-144 on October 16, 2018, authorizing the City Manager or her designee to submit an application to the Ohio Bureau of Worker's Compensation for Ohio Law Enforcement Body Armor Program Grant Funding to provide Seven Thousand Two Hundred Twelve Dollars and Seven Cents (\$7,212.07) to fund the purchase of three (3) body armor vests for the Hudson Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Worker's Compensation for Ohio Law Enforcement Body Armor Program Grant Funding has awarded said grant in the amount of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Twelve Dollars and Seven Cents (\$7,212.07) which is seventy-five percent (75%) of the purchase price of three (3) body armor vests; and

WHEREAS, the City's Police Department budget will be utilized to fund the required matching amount of twenty-five percent (25%) or one thousand eight hundred three dollars and two cents (\$1,803.02) of the remaining cost necessary to purchase three (3) body armor vests; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to affirm the acceptance of said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council authorizes the City Manager or her designee to accept funding from the Ohio Bureau of Worker's Compensation for Ohio Law Enforcement Body Armor Program Grant Funding in the amount of \$7,212.07 for the purpose set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
