## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH THE THRASHER GROUP, INC. FOR THE OWEN BROWN STREET SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson (City) requested a formal statement of qualifications and proposals from experienced consultants for the Owen Brown Street Sidewalk Improvement Project (Project) for the surveying and design of the proposed sidewalk for the proposed Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a contract to the Thrasher Group, Inc. for professional services to survey and design a 5-ft. sidewalk from Lennox to Morse Road along Owen Brown Street, under the existing railroad underpass in an amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$72,268.00), which includes a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to award said contract to the Thrasher Group, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional service contract with the Thrasher Group, Inc. for professional consulting services for the Project, in an amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Eight dollars (\$72,268.00).

<u>Section 2</u>: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
