#### **RENEWAL: NOT A NEW TAX**



The ADM Board levy is a renewal of a 2.95 mill levy passed in 2007. It will cost the owner of a \$100,000 home about \$84.08 per year, or about \$7 per month. The levy represents 78% of the ADM annual operating budget.

The ADM Board funds round the clock crisis services for psychiatric and drug-related emergencies for adults. Last year over 3,500 citizens utilized crisis services, providing a safety net to those at risk for overdose, suicide and other life threatening conditions.

### Treatment for everyone, regardless of ability to pay.

The ADM Board funds treatment for over 12,000 people per year whose care is not covered by Medicaid or traditional insurance. Our network of providers offers a wide array of integrated recovery supports for mental illness and addiction, including residential and outpatient treatment, home-based therapy, services in Summit County Jail and much more.

## 94% of ADM budget is spent on direct treatment, community support and education.

Our services help individuals and families in access services, maintain recovery and keep our community safe. In total our programs impact 50,000 people per year.
