

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING GUIDELINES FOR THE USE AND/OR RENTAL OF SPACE AT CITY HALL AND AT OR UPON OTHER CITY PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to establish guidelines and rules for the use and/or rental of space at City Hall and/or upon or within City owned property; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to permit the use and/or use of City owned properties to the extent that such use promotes charitable purposes and new business enterprises; and,

WHEREAS, this Council finds and concludes that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the City to adopt guidelines for the use and/or rental of space at City Hall and/or other City owned property, as set forth herein for the purposes described above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: That the guidelines and rules for the use and/or rental of space at City Hall and/or upon or within City owned property, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," are hereby adopted.

Section 2: That the rules and guidelines attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

Section 3: That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in a duly noticed, open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
