A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN GROUP FOR ENGINEERING AND HAZARDOUS MATERIAL CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE FORMER YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CENTER DEMOLITION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to proceed with the necessary steps to determine the specifications for a request for bids to demolish buildings at the former Youth Development Center in Hudson (the "Project") and the proposal for engineering consulting and hazardous material services of the Environmental Design Group to prepare those bid specifications is determined to be the lowest and best suited to complete the work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Environmental Design Group for engineering and hazard material consulting services for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$142,294.97 which includes a 10% contingency for possible changes in the scope of services.

<u>Section 2</u>: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to develop bid specifications to complete necessary demolition of buildings that will further the public health, safety and general welfare at the earliest possible time; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
