

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ONSOLVE, LLC FOR EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 15-137, passed by this Council on September 15, 2015, the City Manager entered into an agreement with Emergency Communications Network, LLC for a term from October 1, 2015 through May 31, 2019 for emergency communications services, including "Reverse 9-1-1" (CodeRED) calling and text messaging service; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, Emergency Communications Network, LLC became OnSolve, LLC, and subsequently proposed continuing services of the previously authorized contract under a new agreement for a three-year term from June 1, 2018 through May 31, 2021, and including the option to renew for additional three-year terms thereafter, which was executed by the City Manager, the first year of which was previously authorized; and

WHEREAS, continuing service with OnSolve under the current agreement requires affirmation by City Council; and

WHEREAS, the CodeRED services provided under said agreement have been an effective means of emergency communications, and staff recommends Council affirmation of the current agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio. that:

Section 1. Council affirms the City Manager's action to enter into an agreement with OnSolve, LLC for "Reverse 9-1-1" calling and texting services at a total cost of \$30,300.00, for a term of three years from June 1, 2018 through May 31, 2021, with the option to renew said agreement for successive three year terms thereafter all subject to appropriations by Council and in a form approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
