A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES WITH QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTIONS, INC.; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to a request for proposals, this Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Quality Control Inspections, Inc. for construction management and/or inspection services for various City capital improvement projects and inspections of private developments in 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Quality Control Inspections, Inc. (QCI) for construction management and/or inspection services for City capital improvement projects and inspections of private developments in accordance with the proposal submitted by QCI and in the amounts appropriated by Council for a term from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to become effective by January 1, 2015, so the services being presently provided are not interrupted; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
