

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACCEPTANCE OF
A GRANT FROM THE MARGARET CLARK MORGAN FOUNDATION ON
BEHALF OF THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, with adoption of Resolution No. 16-62 on April 19, 2016, this Council authorized the City Manager, or her designee, to submit a grant application to the Margaret Clark Morgan Foundation on behalf of the Hudson Fire Department to assist with the procurement of a digital fire extinguisher training tool for the purpose of providing training to residents, businesses and students through public education programs; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2016, the Margaret Clark Morgan Foundation awarded and the City Manager accepted said grant in the amount of \$10,000 on behalf of the Hudson Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Department budget will be utilized for additional estimated funds of \$5,300 necessary to procure the digital fire extinguisher training tool.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council affirms the City Manager's acceptance of funding from the Margaret Clark Morgan Foundation in the amount of \$10,000 for the purpose set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
