

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY'S FEDERAL FUNDS AND GRANT POLICIES.**

WHEREAS, from time to time, the City receives federal grants for the improvement of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Hudson and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has prepared policies for the acceptance and handling of federal grants consistent with the federal government's Uniform Guidance for the receipt and expenditure of federal grants; and

WHEREAS, such specified policies will only enhance the City's transparency and future ability to seek and secure federal funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANIED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The City hereby adopts the City of Hudson Federal Funds and Grant Policies attached hereto as Exhibit "A," which is incorporated herein.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
