A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SUMMIT COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SANITARY SEWER SERVICES FOR A SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT THROUGH THE CITY OWNED PARKING LOT ADJACENT TO HEINEN'S GROCERY STORE LOCATED AT 19 CLINTON STREET

WHEREAS, the Summit County Department of Sanitary Sewer Services (DSSS) is proposing to install a new sanitary sewer that would help to alleviate sewer overflows at Brandywine Creek along Owen Brown Street; and

WHEREAS, the project includes running a new sanitary sewer from Owen Brown Street, south along First Street, though the City owned parking lot at Heinen's grocery store to Clinton Street; and,

WHEREAS, the sanitary sewer project is scheduled to start construction the fall of 2024, ahead of the City's proposed parking lot improvements in 2025; and,

WHEREAS, an easement is required and will be used for the installation and future maintenance of the sanitary sewer by the Summit County Department of Sanitary Sewer Services upon completion of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a Sanitary Sewer Easement Agreement with Summit County Department of Sanitary Sewer Services to allow for a new sanitary sewer installation and future maintenance through the City's parking lot adjacent to Heinen's grocery store located at 19 Clinton Street.
- Section 2. That the City Manager and his designee are authorized to sign all documents and do all things necessary to implement this effort.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest	
period allowed by law.
