

RESOLUTION NO. 11-119

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH THE TRUGREEN COMPANY FOR VILLAGE GREENS AND PUBLIC PROPERTIES LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson previously entered into a contract with The TruGreen Company for lawn care, fertilization and aeration, spring and fall clean-up, and trash and debris removal services at the City-owned Village Greens and other City properties which will expire on December 31, 2011, and it is recommended by the Public Works Department to extend this contract for an additional two (2)-year period from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013, as there is no increase in the price of the contract and the Public Works Department has found The TruGreen Company's services to be satisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a two (2)-year extension of the current agreement with The TruGreen Company for a renewal term to begin January 1, 2012 and to run through December 31, 2013, in an amount not to exceed \$31,951.00 for that extension period.

Section 2: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

Section 3: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
