## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AN AARP 2025 COMMUNITY CHALLENGE GRANT.

WHEREAS, AARP has awarded over \$20 million dollars since 2017 to 1,000 communities through the nationwide AARP Livable Communities initiative; and

WHEREAS, AARP's annual grant funding benefits residents, especially those 50+, by improving public spaces, adding transportation or mobility options, supporting an array of housing options, increasing digital connections, or supporting community resilience; and

WHEREAS, the City administration recommends applying for up to \$25,000 in grant funding for public wi-fi improvement on the downtown greens, including replacement of outdated infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager and his designee are hereby authorized to apply for the AARP's 2025 Community Challenge Grant and, in particular, for public wi-fi infrastructure upgrades for the City.
- Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
