Special Recognition of Constitution Week 2014

WHEREAS, September 17, 2014, marks the two hundred and twenty-seventh anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and,

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and the anniversary of its creation; and,

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and,

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America, designating September 17 through September 23 as Constitution Week.
