

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AN ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the federal Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, the Federal Emergency Management Agency provides funding for needed resources to enhance the safety of the public and safety force personnel and accepts applications for Assistance to Firefighters Grants; and

WHEREAS, an Assistance to Firefighters Grant (the "Grant") could provide up to 90% of estimated costs for two powered cot systems for ambulances; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the City Manager apply for a grant to help fund two powered cot systems for ambulances, on behalf of Hudson Emergency Medical Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute and file an application with the Federal Emergency Management Agency and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
