A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH JANCO SERVICE INDUSTRIES FOR HOUSEKEEPING/CLEANING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson previously entered into a contract with Janco Service Industries for housekeeping and general cleaning services in City-owned buildings and facilities which will expire on December 31, 2011 and it is recommended by the Public Works Department to extend this contract for an additional two (2)-year period from January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013, as there is no increase in the price of the contract and the Public Works Department has found Janco Service Industries' services to be satisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a two (2)-year extension of the current agreement with Janco Service Industries for a renewal term to begin January 1, 2012 and to run through December 31, 2013, in an amount not to exceed \$79,331.00 for that extension period.

Section 2: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
