

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE HERRICK PARK DRIVE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER.

WHEREAS, residents between Benjamin Circle and Herrick Park Drive, within the Woods of the Western Reserve Subdivision, have notified the City that during heavy rains, flows from Benjamin Circle drainage system bypass the pipe network at the rear of the properties and cause overland flooding near their homes; and

WHEREAS, consequently, a storm sewer hydraulic study was completed during August, 2023 and identified that the overland flooding can be reduced by modifying the existing pipe network; and

WHEREAS, drainage flows between 2191 and 2203 Benjamin Circle will be modified with a larger downstream pipe and headwall to reduce the amount of water bypassing the existing storm pipe network; and

WHEREAS, additional piping will be added to reduce the flooding in the rear of the properties along with modifications to the drainage channel with no negative impacts to downstream properties; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Policy for Work on Private property has been reviewed and was found to apply to this project based on the following:

- 1A. Public Nuisance and Public Benefit;
- 1B. Reduces Flood Risk;
- 1C. The drainage area is greater than 5 acres; and
3. Exceeds Residents Capacity to Resolve.

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department will design the project in-house and the storm sewer work is planned for outside of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the estimated project cost of construction, including a 10% contingency, is \$134,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of construction bids for the purpose of seeking the lowest and best bidder for the

Herrick Park Drive Drainage Improvement Project in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.

Section 2. The City Manager and/or his designee is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City in an amount up to that which has been appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor and the approval as to form by the City Solicitor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not in excess of the Engineer's estimate at the time of bidding, including a ten percent (10%) contingency, which together currently totals \$134,000.

Section 3. The City Manager and/or his designee is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.

Section 4. The aforesaid project is in the City and its residents' best interest.

Section 5. The above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
