A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT ACT AREA AGREEMENT WITH TJE REAL ESTATE, LLC, GEM EDWARDS INC., GEMCARE WELLNESS INC., ADVANCED HEALTH TECHNOLOGIES, EDWARDS HEALTH CARE SERVICES, AND TEMEG HOLDINGS INC.; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Hudson has encouraged the development of real property located in the area designated as Community Reinvestment Act ("CRA") Area #4; and

WHEREAS, TJE Real Estate, LLC as property owner and GEM Edwards Inc. (DBA as GEMCO Medical), GemCare Wellness Inc, Advanced Health Technologies (DBA as Gem Edwards Pharmacy), Edwards Health Care Services Inc. and TEMEG Holdings Inc. (DBA as GEMCORE) (collectively, "Employers") has submitted an application to Hudson for real estate tax relief under the CRA; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has investigated the application of TJE Real Estate, LLC and the Employers and has recommended the same to the Council of Hudson on the basis that this applicant is qualified by financial responsibility and business experience to create and preserve employment opportunities in said Community Reinvestment Area and improve the economic climate of Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a Community Reinvestment Area Agreement with TJE Real Estate, LLC and the Employers, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto as <u>"Exhibit A"</u> and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.
- <u>Section 2</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason it is immediately necessary in order to create employment opportunities within the City of Hudson at the earliest possible time; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council except that six
