B. <u>15-14</u> AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S PAY RANGE ASSIGNMENTS SCHEDULE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE 14-161, PASSED DECEMBER 17, 2014: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
