A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR A FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Fire Department is eligible to purchase vehicles through the Community, University and Education Cooperative Association (C.U.E.) Program; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has received a quote from Montrose Ford, Fairlawn, Ohio, under the C.U.E. Program for a 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor Utility vehicle in the amount of \$26,467.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Montrose Ford, Fairlawn, Ohio for a 2015 Ford Explorer Interceptor Utility vehicle for a total not to exceed \$26,467.00, which purchase amount is approved in the 2015 City Budget.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to obtain a replacement safety vehicle for the Fire Department at the earliest possible time for the continued protection of persons and property in the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
