Charter of the City of Hudson, Ohio

Article XVI: General Provisions

SECTION 16.01 EFFECTIVE DATE OF CHARTER.

For the purpose of nominating and electing officers of this Municipality and fixing the compensation of those to be elected in 1957, this Charter shall be in effect from and after the date of its approval by the electors and for all other purposes the Charter shall be in effect on and after the sixth (6th) day of January, 1958.

SECTION 16.02 EFFECT OF PARTIAL INVALIDITY.

The determination that any part of this Charter is invalid shall not invalidate or impair the force or effect of any other part hereof except to the extent that such other part is wholly dependent for its operation upon the part declared invalid.

SECTION 16.03 EFFECT OF THE CHARTER UPON EXISTING LAWS AND RIGHTS.

The adoption of this Charter shall not affect any pre-existing rights of the Municipality, nor any rights or liability or pending suit or prosecution, either on behalf of or against the Municipality or any officer thereof, nor any franchise granted by the Municipality, nor pending proceedings for the authorization of public improvements or the levy of assessments therefor. Except as a contrary intent appears herein, all acts of the Council of the Municipality shall continue in effect until lawfully amended or repealed.
