

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE GPD GROUP FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE BARLOW ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to perform a street and intersections improvement project for Barlow Road from Terex Road to Darrow Road (SR 91) (the "Project") and the proposal for engineering design services of the GPD Group is determined to be the best qualified to complete the work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the GPD Group for engineering design services for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$323,641, which includes a 10% contingency amount.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this important improvement project to be designed and completed at the earliest possible time so as to continue to provide safe travel over City streets; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
