OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR PREFABRICATED PUBLIC RESTROOM STRUCTURES FOR THREE CITY PARKS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is authorized to purchase materials and related equipment through the National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA"); and

WHEREAS, the City is in need of more permanent, safe and sanitary public restroom structures at its public parks, specifically Oak Grove Park, Colony Park and Cascade Park; and

WHEREAS, acceptable prefabricated concrete restroom structures may be purchased from and installed by CXT Concrete Buildings at a proper and acceptable price through the NJPA.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into on behalf of the City a purchase agreement with CXT Concrete Buildings in the amount of \$127,017.00, which includes a 10% contingency, for the purchase and installation of three (3) prefabricated concrete public restroom structures at the three (3) City parks set forth in the recitals of this Resolution through the NJPA cooperative purchasing program.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to make the purchase of and order the subject structures to keep the City's parks healthy and safe for the public; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
