DACCED.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH GAMETIME FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase equipment through bids obtained by cooperative purchasing programs – here, through U.S. Communities Pricing Program;

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a quote from GameTime under the U.S. Communities Pricing Program, Contract No. 040376, for playground equipment for the City parks in the amount of \$29,010.59.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with GameTime under the U.S. Communities Pricing Program, Contract No. 040376, for playground equipment for the City parks for an amount not to exceed \$29,010.59.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase the equipment within the next twelve days in order to obtain a \$7,151.29 savings on the purchase; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
