A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A TRUCK THROUGH THE COMMUNITY, UNIVERSITY & EDUCATION PURCHASING ASSOCIATION (C.U.E.) PROGRAM FOR THE WATER RESOURCES DIVISION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson, as a member of the C.U.E. purchasing cooperative, is permitted to purchase vehicles through its competitive bidding process and as specified in previous legislation passed by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of a truck for the City's Water Resources Division's operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement, through the C.U.E. purchasing program, with Montrose Auto Group for the purchase of one 2016 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 truck at a cost not to exceed \$31,000, and as said amount has been approved in the 2015 City Budget.

<u>Section 2</u>: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid purchase must be made as soon as possible to secure the specific vehicles for the provision of critical public services; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
