A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR A SPECIAL PROJECTS GRANT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency provides funding for special projects that provide for mitigation, preparedness, response and/or recovery in the area of emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency could provide up to \$21,000 in funding for an all-terrain vehicle and trailer for the Fire Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to apply to the Summit County Emergency Management Agency for a Special Projects Grant to fund an all-terrain vehicle and trailer for the Fire Department for the reasons set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

<u>Section 2:</u> This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare of the City and its residents and for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to timely meet the deadline for submission of the application and to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
