A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF PLAYGROUND SHADE STRUCTURES FOR VETERANS WAY PARK; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Parks Department is in need of purchasing and installing playground shade structures at Veterans Way Park as soon as possible to timely meet the needs of citizens during the approaching warmer weather; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and ordinances and under State law, the City Manager may purchase goods or services through bids obtained by cooperative purchasing programs when authorized by action of Council – here, through the U.S. Communities Pricing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a quote from GameTime, c/o David Williams & Associates, Inc. under the U.S. Communities Pricing Program, Contract No. 110179, for the purchase and installation of playground shade structures for the City parks in the amount of \$41,330.17.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with GameTime, c/o David Williams & Associates, Inc., under U.S. Communities Pricing Program, Contract No. 110179, for the purchase and installation of playground shade structures for the Veterans Way Park playground for an amount not to exceed \$41,330.17.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase and install the shade structures in time for summer; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
