

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FIREHOUSE SUBS FOUNDATION TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR TRAINING EQUIPMENT FOR THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Firehouse Subs Foundation provides grant funding for community safety and fire prevention education programs; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the City Manager apply for a grant to fund an electronic fire extinguisher training tool, valued at approximately \$15,300, on behalf of the City Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute and file an application with the Firehouse Subs Foundation and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare of the City and its residents and for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to timely meet the deadline for submission of the application and to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
