

RESOLUTION NO. 16-134

OFFERED BY: MAYOR BASIL

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR FINAL DESIGN AND ASSOCIATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE RELOCATION OF THE CITY'S SALT DOME AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUS GARAGE FACILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 16-79, authorizing the City Manager to seek proposals for the final design and associated professional services for the project to relocate the School District bus garage and the City's salt storage structures (the "Project"), necessary to move forward with Phase II of the Downtown Redevelopment project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a request for proposals, City staff recommends the Environmental Design Group be engaged by the City for the final design and associated professional services as the lowest and best proposal received for the Project; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to accept the proposal for the final design and associated professional services of the Environmental Design Group as the lowest and best of the three proposals submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with the Environmental Design Group for the final design and associated professional services for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$467,440.00, which includes a 10% contingency amount in excess of the proposal that was submitted.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to proceed with the work set forth in the recitals to this Resolution at the earliest possible time in order to move forward with Phase II of the Downtown Redevelopment project under the timetable therefor; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
