

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY'S SERVICE DIVISION FOR A TRENCH BOX.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (OBWC) provides Safety Intervention Grant Program funding to Ohio public employers who wish to purchase equipment to substantially reduce or eliminate injuries and illnesses associated with a particular task or operation; and

WHEREAS, the OBWC could provide Safety Intervention Grant Program funding on a 75% (OBWC) / 25% (City) matching basis to assist with funding of a trench box for the Service Division, valued at approximately \$12,000, for utilization in storm sewer excavation work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to apply for a 75% / 25% matching grant to the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for Safety Intervention Grant Program funding for the reason set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
