

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY'S EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (OBWC) provides Safety Intervention Grant Program funding to Ohio public employers who wish to purchase equipment to substantially reduce or eliminate injuries and illnesses associated with a particular task or operation; and

WHEREAS, the OBWC could provide up to \$40,000 in Safety Intervention Grant Program funding on a 75% (OBWC) / 25% (City) matching basis to assist with funding of a power ambulance cot and power cot loading system for one of the Hudson Emergency Medical Service ambulances; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted a grant application by the deadline of December 31, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the City Manager's actions to execute and file an application with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for Safety Intervention Grant Program, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Safety Intervention Grant Program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
