

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LIBERTA CONSTRUCTION FOR THE NORTH MAIN STREET AND PROSPECT STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, SUM-91-15.20 (PID 88548); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the City's North Main Street and Prospect Street Intersection Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, this Project will be funded on the basis of an 80% reimbursement of costs from the Ohio Department of Transportation using federal funds and 20%, plus any contingency amounts, to be paid by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has recommended that the bid of Liberta Construction be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid and to add to the contract \$9,556.00 in-lieu of certain items as explained to this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Liberta Construction as being the lowest and best bid and to approve the amount of the in-lieu of certain items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid of Liberta Construction for the North Main Street and Prospect Street Intersection Improvement Project in the amount of \$848,567.60, plus \$9,556.00 in-lieu of certain items, plus a 10% contingency amount of \$85,812.36, for a total contract amount of \$943,935.96 is accepted and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Liberta Construction for said amount.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project for the safety of the motoring public and to meet the City's contractual deadline to award this bid; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
