

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ORKEESWA SCHOOL IN ORKEESWA VILLAGE, TANZANIA, AFRICA, BY DESIGNATING THE SCHOOL AS A TOUCHSTONE AND POINT OF CONTACT FOR THE COMMITMENT TO SUPPORTING VULNERABLE POPULATIONS WHEREVER THEY MAY BE AND AN INDICATION OF THE DESIRE TO FOCUS EFFORTS TOWARD THE SOLUTION OF GLOBAL PROBLEMS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson desires to promote and cultivate support of vulnerable populations worldwide; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is appropriate to encourage Hudson citizens to continue to support global issues affecting children; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the adoption of Orkeeswa School does not require any funding nor does this action give preferential status to this cause over other charities or similar works within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that this adoption would serve as a focal point to allow the residents of Hudson, especially its youth, to learn more about global issues affecting children and to make a meaningful difference worldwide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Hudson expresses its desire to promote and cultivate support for global issues affecting children and to make a meaningful difference worldwide by adopting the Orkeeswa School as a touchstone and point of contact for the commitment to supporting vulnerable populations wherever they may be and as an indication of the desire to focus efforts toward the solution of global problems. This document of support has been formulated to promote these worthwhile goals.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
