A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MICHAEL BAKER INTERNATIONAL FOR ENGINEERING AND DESIGN CONSULTING SERVICES FOR PHASE 3 OF THE VETERANS TRAIL PROJECT (PID 97856); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-145, adopted by this Council on December 3, 2014, the City Manager entered into a Lead Public Agency Federal Project Agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Veterans Trail Project (PID 97856); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a request for proposals, City staff recommends Michael Baker International be engaged by the City for professional services as the best proposal received for engineering and design consulting services for a multi-use path between Veterans Way Park and Barlow Road (the "Project") necessary to move forward with Phase 3 of the Veterans Trail Project (PID 97856); and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to accept the proposal for professional services of Michael Baker International as the best of the six proposals submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Michael Baker International for professional services for the Project in an amount not to exceed \$250,000, which includes an 8.5% contingency amount.

<u>Section 2:</u> This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to design this project that will further the public health, safety and general welfare at the earliest possible time; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
