A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OHM ADVISORS FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN OF THE VALLEY VIEW STORM WATER POND PROJECT (PID 101636); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson must construct a storm water pond on the north side of I-80, south of Valley View Road and west of State Route 91, to aid in the proper handling of storm water runoff from the Ohio Turnpike and other upstream areas (the "Project), and the proposal for engineering design services of OHM Advisors is determined to be the best qualified to complete the work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with OHM Advisors for engineering design services of the Project in an amount not to exceed \$39,600, which includes a 10% contingency amount.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this important improvement project to be designed and completed at the earliest possible time so as to protect persons and property from storm water flooding; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
