

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR A CLEAN OHIO TRAILS FUND GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON PARKS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Clean Ohio Trails Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Clean Ohio Trails Fund could provide up to 75% of estimated costs for Veterans Trail Phase IV (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, City Council desires for the City to receive financial assistance for the Project under the Clean Ohio Trails Fund Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council approves filing an application for Clean Ohio Trails Fund financial assistance for the Project.

Section 2: The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources ("ODNR") and to provide to ODNR all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3: By this Resolution, this Council obligates the City of Hudson to provide the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed Project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of the Clean Ohio Trails Fund Program.

Section 4: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the general welfare of the City and its residents for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to timely meet the deadline for submission of the application and to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
