

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, FOR AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMS.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, provides grants to assist emergency medical services (“EMS”) organizations with the purchase of approved training and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, could provide a partial reimbursement for the purchase of a Child CRISis Manikin for the City of Hudson EMS, valued at \$5,400.00; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires for the City to receive financial assistance for this training equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
