

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FOR A 2017 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SPECIAL PROJECTS GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BENEFIT THE SUMMIT METRO CRASH RESPONSE TEAM.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency administers the 2017 Emergency Management Special Projects Grant Program, which provides financing to benefit the general population of Summit County through the four primary functions of emergency management: mitigation, preparedness, and response and/or recovery with multi-jurisdictional teams receiving greater consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Emergency Management Agency could provide a 2017 Emergency Management Special Projects Grant (the “Grant”) for up to \$30,000 to benefit the Summit Metro Crash Response Team, of which the Hudson Police Department is a member, to fund the purchase of a Faro Focus S350 laser scanner for crash investigation and re-creation with no matching funds required from the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted such a Grant application by the deadline of February 6, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby affirms the City Manager’s action to submit an application to the Summit County Emergency Management Agency, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
