A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE FLEET VEHICLE FOR PARKS DIVISION OPERATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter, Section 6.04 of Article VII, as a member of the Community, University & Education Purchasing Association (C.U.E.) purchasing cooperative, the City of Hudson is permitted to purchase vehicles through the C.U.E. competitive bidding process; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price from Montrose Auto Group, Akron, Ohio, through the C.U.E. bidding process for one 2017 Ford Explorer in the amount of \$29,315.94 for Parks Division operations for the purpose of replacing a vehicle at the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of one (1) vehicle to replace a vehicle in the City's vehicle fleet for Parks Division operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement through the C.U.E. purchasing program with Montrose Auto Group, Akron, Ohio for the purchase of one 2017 Ford Explorer at a total cost not to exceed \$29,315.94, and as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget.

<u>Section 2:</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid purchase must be made as soon as possible to secure the lowest price; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
