A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BAKER VEHICLE SYSTEMS, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A COMPACT TRACK LOADER FOR PARKS DIVISION OPERATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase equipment through the Government Services Administration Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price quote from Baker Vehicle Systems, Inc., Macedonia, Ohio, under Government Services Administration Contract Pricing No. GS-30F-1021H, for the purchase of one compact track loader ("skid steer") in the amount of \$63,503.00 for the purpose of replacing equipment at the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of a compact track loader for the City's Parks Division operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Baker Vehicle Systems, Inc., Macedonia, Ohio, under the Government Service Administration Contract Pricing No. GS-30F-1021H for one compact track loader at a total cost not to exceed \$63,503.00 and as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget.

<u>Section 2:</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid purchase must be made as soon as possible to secure the specific equipment for the provision of critical public services and to secure the lowest price; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
