

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, FOR AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND TRAINING GRANT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 17-21 adopted by this Council on February 7, 2017, the City Manager submitted an application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, for an Emergency Medical Services and Training Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Emergency Medical Services and Training Grant application has been accepted for funding to reimburse \$4,800 towards expenses relating to the purchase of a Child CRISis Manikin valued at approximately \$5,400, and the City's EMS budget will be utilized for the remaining cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to accept funding from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, for an Emergency Medical Services and Training Grant in the amount of \$4,800 for the purpose set forth in the recitals to this Resolution and to supplement the grant with approximately \$600 from the City's EMS appropriation that is currently budgeted.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
