I. Call To Order

Chair Drummond called to order the regularly scheduled meeting of the Architectural & Historic Board of Review of the City of Hudson at 7:30 p.m., in accordance with the Sunshine Laws of the State of Ohio, O.R.C. Section 121.22.

III. Public Comment

Chair Drummond opened the meeting to public comments for anyone wanting to address the Board on any item. There being no one wishing to make public comment, Chair Drummond closed this portion of the meeting.

IV. Consent Applications

There were no consent applications.

V. New Business

A. 676 126 Aurora Street

Accessory Structure (demolition of existing detached garage and build new garage) Submitted by New Creation Builders - Historic District

The Historic District Subcommittee reviewed the application. Ms. Diane Bija, of New Creations Builders, and Mr. Bill Morris, owner of the property, were present for the meeting and discussion.

The Board asked if restoring or rehabilitating the present garage was considered. Ms. Bija and Mr. Morris said that the present garage has been deemed beyond repair or rehabilitation. The Board also asked if other materials were considered instead of using vinyl siding. Discussion took place regarding the requirement that the thirty-foot wall have windows every twelve feet.

The Board tabled the application, so that a site visit could be scheduled.

B. 885 135 Elm Street

Alteration (change to previously approved front porch, lattice skirting replaced with stone, addition of two stone columns)

Submitted by Shane Reid.

Mr. Shane Reid and Ms. Rebecca Reid were present for the meeting and discussion.

Ms. Soloman introduced the case by stating that this application was originally approved administratively. When work began stone material was used instead of the approved lattice. Also two additional columns were added to to the three that were previously approved.

The Board discussed the use of stone in place of the approved lattice and noted that the stone does not match the existing materials used on the foundation of the structure. Also discussed was that this type of stone on the foundation is not appropriate for a house of this age.

Mr. and Mrs. Reid requested that the application be tabled. They will discuss the application with staff and return with revised plans.

C. 753 115 College Street

Alteration (Alteration to the previous approval for the renovation of Seymour Hall - revise four windows on the west elevation)

Submitted by Robert Russ, MCF Architects - Historic District

Mr. Robert Russ representing MCF Architects was present for the meeting and discussion regarding wall partitions falling in the middle of four windows.

The Board considered this request a substantial change to the exterior of historic Seymore Hall and stated that interior changes should not dictate the exterior look of the building.

Ms. Marzulla, representing the Historic District Subcommittee recommended that the application be denied. Mr. Congin accepted the recommendation of the Historic District Subcommittee and made the motion to deny the application. Mr. Waldeck seconded the motion.

Mr. Marzulla moved to recommend to Hudson City Council the expansion of historical district as presented. Mr. Grant seconded the motion.
