A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH UNIVAR COMPANY FOR ROCK SALT FOR THE CITY'S WATER TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson needs to purchase rock salt to regenerate softening equipment at its water treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the City competitively bid the purchase of said rock salt and the lowest and best bid on the per ton basis was from the Univar Company;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson an agreement with Univar Company for purchases of rock salt at a total cost not to exceed the amount budgeted and appropriated for such purchases of rock salt for the Division of Water Resources for 2018.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
