## 1. Call to Order

## 2. Correspondence and Council Comments

Mayor Basil stated that the Hudson Fire Open House that was held on Sunday, October 8, 2017 was a great event and had a wonderful turn-out.

*Mr.* Hanink mentioned that he had looked at the wrong budget line at the September 26, 2017 Council Workshop regarding Velocity Broadband and apologized to staff.

This meeting will focus primarily on the Road Program and Public Works Areas including Street Maintenance, Fleet, Water, Electric and Storm Water.
