## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE DOWNTOWN HUDSON TRAIL & GREENWAY CONCEPT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Hudson Parks Master Plan, adopted by this Council with Resolution No. 00-126 on September 20, 2000, recommended implementing a citywide trail network to make Hudson a more cohesive and livable community, encourage economic growth, increase property values, and link the community with the surrounding region; and

WHEREAS, the Connectivity Plan, adopted by this Council with Resolution No. 14-12 on February 19, 2014, established a framework of priorities for developing connecting trails, pathways, and sidewalks throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, plans for the Veterans Trail include a sixteen-mile trail that runs from the Summit Metro Parks Hike and Bike Trail on Barlow Road, through Hudson for approximately six miles, and ends at the Summit Metro Parks Hike and Bike Trail on East Hines Hill Road; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Hudson Trail & Greenway Concept Plan provides a viable solution to route the Veterans Trail through downtown Hudson from Owen Brown Street to Veterans Park; and

WHEREAS, it is this Council's desire to adopt the Downtown Hudson Trail & Greenway Concept Plan.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1:</u> That the attached Downtown Hudson Trail & Greenway Concept Plan is adopted by this Council in concept and, furthermore, that it shall be understood that formal implementation of any of the projects or positions identified in this Plan requires specific annual appropriation approval by this Council as provided in the City's Annual Appropriation Ordinance (Annual Budget) or any supplemental appropriation occurring throughout the year. <u>Section 2:</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
